| | The Following Activities Have Various Restrictions | | | |
| Recreational Fires Including campfires, charcoal fires, cooking fires and warming fires. The use of portable appliances such as camp stoves and fire pits using liquified or bottled fuels are allowed in clear areas free of flammable vegetation. The following is required where open fires and appliances are allowed; one shovel and one gallon of water or one 2 ½ pound fire extinguisher. | Allowed with Landowner Approval | Only at Designated Sites | Only at Designated Sites | Prohibited |
| Non-Industrial Power Saws When allowed each saw must have one shovel and one ABC fire extinguisher of at least 8 ounce capacity and be equipped with a spark arresting screen. A fire watch is required for one hour following the use of a saw. | Allowed All Day | Allowed All Day | Allowed Before 1 pm or after 8 pm | Prohibited |
| Motor Vehicles Allowed on improved roads. In addition, each vehicle traveling on forestlands, must have one shovel and one gallon of water or a 2.5 lb. or larger ABC fire extinguisher. | Allowed All Day | Allowed All Day | Allowed All Day | Allowed All Day |
| Off-Road Motorized Vehicles On Designated Trails and Unimproved Roads must have a 2.5 lb. or larger fire extinguisher. | Allowed All Day | Allowed All Day | Allowed Before 1pm or after 8 pm | Prohibited |
| Cutting, Grinding, or Welding of Metal When allowed, is restricted to areas that are cleared of flammable materials and have either a charged hose or 2.5 lb. or larger ABC fire extinguisher. | Allowed All Day | Allowed All Day | Allowed Before 1pm or after 8 pm | Prohibited |
| Mowing/Cutting of Dried, Cured Grass The cultivation and harvest of agricultural crops is exempt from this requirement. | Allowed All Day | Allowed All Day | Allowed Before 1pm or after 8 pm | Prohibited |
| Other Spark-Emitting Internal Combustion Engine When allowed, is restricted to areas that are cleared of flammable materials and have either a charged hose or 2.5 lb. or larger ABC fire extinguisher. | Allowed All Day | Allowed All Day | Allowed Before 1pm or after 8 pm | Prohibited |

Additional restrictions or closures may be in place by landowners or public land management agencies on the lands they own or manage.

These restrictions shall remain in effect until replaced, suspended, or terminated by an additional proclamation of the State Forester or an authorized representative.
